# **WORKS IN RIU GIRONA**

Last week finalized works for prevention of floods. An action that has been divided into two parts, on one hand the extension of 10m and reinforcement of the left margin, with what has been done managed to increase the capacity of drainage in 1,500 m3 in order to protect the houses near the river against possible flooding.

On the other hand, the "gual" was also rebuilt, which was impassable after the episode of torrential rainfall in December 2016. Now, this structure has been redone extending from 3 to 10 this structure, extending from 3 to 10 frames of 1m of height, with which it has increased considerably its capacity to drain. This will allow pedestrians and cyclists to cross the river when it is dry or little water runs. By this way, it will facilitate access to the recreation area and to students who go to the Benicadim CEIP school and to the bus stop.

The works have always been supervised by an engineer and by the Confederation Hydrographic of the



Jucar, having had a cost of 60,000 €, of which 85% took over the Generalitat Valenciana through the subsidy plan for works destined to the prevention of floods.

#### **SKATE DAY**










On the morning of Thursday, December 28th, the skatepark of the Girona River Recreation Area was the stage of the first Skate Day of Beniarbeig. The event, organized by the Department of Culture, gathered about twenty young people interested in skating, who along with the companions filled the river park. The skating session began with the explanations of Javi Alarcón and Sergi Ortolà, two young skaters from Ondara who first showed the most basic tricks, to little by little, increase the difficulty. They also explained the different parts of which it is composed the skatepark helping the assistants to begin in the handling and guidance of the skateboard in the simplest tricks. Then the demonstration was carried out by Javi and Sergi, who tested their skateboards using all the objects on the track.

## **Services Staff**

Last Friday, December 15th, four new employees were incorporated in the area of staff municipal services. They will carry out tasks of cleaning, painting and construction during a period of six months. This recruitment has been carried out through the programs SEPE (State Public Employment Service) and are framed within the EMCORP and EMCORD programs of the SERVEF.



## **Girona's River Recreation Area**



As already mentioned in previous bulletins, the Recreational Area of the Girona River is a service that is available to all citizens as a space of recreation. They can make use of this equipment residents and non-residents, the former must make a deposit of 20 € and for those who are not residents, will have a cost 25 €, in addition to the deposit. The facilities have barbecues, tables, toilets and water service, also has a children's playground and a skate

park, which is a very suitable space for families with children.

Procedures and any questions, you can contact the Town Hall. During the past year 2017, this service was used 39 times and 800 people passed, without counting the events organized by the town hall. Of all these days of use, 87% of the applications were made by users residents in Beniarbeig and the remaining 13% by non-residents.

#### Sant Antoni Fest

The traditional fest of San Antonio was held last Sunday, January 14th. The day began with the chivalry parade of the whole region, which walked the streets of Beniarbeig with the image of San Antonio leading the entourage. Horses, "hacas", donkeys and ponies accompanied the image to the church where Mass began in honor of the Saint. Next, preceded the blessing of the animals in the square of the town hall. Following, the recreational area of the Girona River progressively gathered 300 people for lunch a giant Puchero (traditional meal) organized by the town hall. The act also counted on the participation of the Fiestas Commission 2018, who provided the bar and music service.

# **Memory Workshop**

## Cemetery





Last week began the remodeling and extension work of the municipal cemetery. This action is within the "Provincial Plan of Works and Services of Municipal Competition of the Deputation of Alicante» and will consist of, on one hand, the elimination of 116 niches that are in very poor condition, since they were built in the XIX century and will be replaced by 104 new niches of concrete. On the other hand, 6 underground pits will also be constructed for burials, in columns of three overlapping pits, with a total of 18 pits. Finally, a part of the pavement will be replaced, a space will be set to fix the flowers and an ossuary will also be provided, a service required by Decree 195/2009, of October 30th of the Counsel.


These are the subsidies that the City Council of Beniarbeig has received from the Provincial Council of Alicante since the publication of the last BIM:

## Waste Campaign



Since the waste management company ECOEMBES has submitted the separate collection report for light packaging (Yellow containers) and paper-cardboard (blue containers) 2015, with the data relating to the management area A1, which includes the regions of Marina Alta, Marina Baja and the municipality of El Campello. The document, among others things refers to the average in kilograms of these

wastes that every citizen recycles annually, and , as can be observed clearly in terms of recycling the Valencian Community (8.6 kg / inhabitant / year) is still very far from the surrounding territories, such as Catalonia (13.2), Islas Baleares (18.5) and Aragón (11.2).

At the municipal level it does not improve either, as with light packaging, Beniarbeig so only contributes 8 kg / hab / year, when the average area is in 12 kg / hab / year, and far from towns of the region such as Vall de Gallinera (37.3), Teulada (33.6), Orba (31) and Xàbia (27.4). This same situation also occurs in the case of paper-carton recycling, where Beniarbeig is situates in 10.5 kg / hab / year compared to the average that is in 17.4 kg / hab / year and much difference of neighboring villages like the Vall de Gallinera (65), Teulada (63) and Atzúbia (51).

The non-classification of waste, apart from the environmental consequences also has a greater economic cost for the city council, since the collection of lightweight containers and paper-cardboard has no type of cost for the town hall. On the other hand, the collection of classified organic waste has a great impact on the municipal coffers, since the municipality has to pay in relation to the amount of non-recycled bundle that the company must collect.



In this way, from the Department of the Environment we want to remember the importance of separating the waste, because apart from contributing to a more sustainable world, it is also contributing in a substantial way to energy and economic savings.




# **WHATSAPP**

## LITERARY ENCOUNTERS



Simona Škrabec «Una pàtria prestada. Lectures de fragilitat»

The Encontres (Encounters) at Beniarbeig arrive this 2018 to its fifth edition. This year the literary days want to be a review of the four previous announcements , with a program consisting of a speaker from each of the editions of the conference. In this way, the cycle of conferences will begin on Thursday, February 8th at 7:30 p.m. with "Una Pàtria Prestatada. Lectures de Fragilitat" by Simona Škrabec, which is based on the book of the same name. On the basis of this, Škrabec reflects on the role of literature as a total cohesion factor and the formation of national identities. Her analysis and point of view, unusual and new, hints at the dense network of connections between politics and culture.

Simona Škrabec (Ljubljana, Slovenia, 1968) is a writer, philologist and translator. She has a degree in German Philology and comparative literature from the University of Ljubljana and a PhD in comparative literature from the Autonomous University of Barcelona. She has lived in Catalonia for 25 years, from where she has developed an intense work of translation between Catalan and Slovenian. She has been the editor of VISA, the digital magazine of literature and translations of PEN Catalán, the Catalan section of PEN



International, an association of writers founded in 1921 and present in 104 countries.

During the month of March, appointments continue with the Encontres (Literary Encounters), on March 1st , Joan Francesc Mira will revisit with the lecture "L'ofici i La Responsabilitat del Traductor des de les Meues Traduccions" and on March 22nd the guest will be Antoni Furió , with the conference "Joan Fuster i la Història". Then, on April 19th will be the turn of Antoni Riera, who will talk about the "Aspectes de l'alimentació a l'època Medieval y Moderna". Finally, on May 10th , Carmen Alemany will be in charge of closing the conferences with "La Poesia Cubana Després de la Revolució." Finally, the show "Balls en Valls", originally scheduled for January, has been moved to May 24th.



Una patria prestada: lecturas de fragilidad en la literatura catalana

## Simona Škrabec



Fragility readings. Throughout the 20th century, the Catalan identity emerged from the ashes like a phoenix. This book aims to show the importance of literature to unite a society without shying away from the most difficult issues. The works are commented on in the context of universal literature and go beyond the Catalan case, signing up themselves in thought around in formation of the entities in Europe.

## Reading Club

The novel *El Viaje del Elefante* (2008) by Jose Saramago has been the book with which we have passed the year, a reading that, surprisingly, has been liked by all members of the club. The trip from Portugal to Vienna is an adventure full of metaphors, with a lot of humor in charge of the elephant, its cornac (person in charge of the handling of the elephant) and the whole delegation sent in the 16th century as a gift from the King John III of Portugal to his cousin Archduke Maximilian of Austria.

The next book on which we will work is the well-known novel *Crematorio* (2007), by Rafael Chirbes. The objective is to get closer to the most recent work of Chirbes through a novel that has been awarded the Critics' Prize, the Critic of Valencia Prize, the Cálamo Prize and the Dulce Chacón Prize. In addition, it has also been adapted to the screen with the homonymous TV series of 2011, starring actor Pepe Sancho. That is why we have also taken the opportunity to purchase the series on DVD and work it for the next meeting of the Reading Club, which is scheduled for Tuesday, March 27th at 6:00 p.m.

The death of Matías Bertomeu, the ideologist who changed revolution for agriculture, sets in motion the mechanisms that make up *Crematorio*. The pain returns the reverse of lives raised on dark foundations: that of Matías's brother, Rubén, the unscrupulous builder; the one of Silvia, the daughter of Rubén, art restorer, married with Juan Mullor, the professor who prepares the biography of Federico Brouard, old friend of tBertomeu, an alcoholic writer who lives failure on his last days; of Ramón Collado, the man who made the dirty works of the builder; of Traian, the Russian Mafia, old partner of Rubén; and Monica's, the very young and ambitious wife. Chirbes offers us a terrible panorama: corruption as a sap that runs through the whole body of a society in which the destruction of the landscape acquires the value of a symbol.



Chirbes deploys a world abandoned by the gods in which words and ideas are only wrappers, and art and literature, inane toys. Rafael Chirbes shows us, in this great novel, more radical, fiercer, more «Francis Bacon» and better writer than ever.

## Incorporation to the Valencia Public Reading Network

The library has already been integrated into the XLPV, this will allow access to more subsidies, and since soon it will also be integrated into the Electronic Network, with which users will be able to consult books and other materials available in the library, renew loans and have the network card, which can make loans in any library.


