Beniarbeig, the first village in the Marina Alta to convert plastic tops into urban furniture

"Making the people aware of the importance of recycling and educating on the potential and the possibilities of recyclable rubbish". With these words, the councillor for the environment sums up the symbolic initiative with which Beniarbeig town hall has taken a big step forward in respect of the use of recycled materials as a basis for a more sustainable and ecological management of waste materials.

After installing a heart shaped container in the Plaza del 9 de Octubre to collect bottle tops, a public bench made from the same material which the people

of Beniarbeig have recycled has also been installed next to the container.

The technical management of the project has been done by the Valencian company CM Plástico. Beniarbeig thus becomes the first village in the

Marina Alta to convert recycled material into urban furniture.

Beniarbeig Town Hall has stressed the importance of the intervention for future efforts, as the bottle tops which continue to be collected will be used for community support and for other projects in the village.



Beniarbeig is preparing its fiesta week in honour of San Roque from 20th to 29th August. At the beginning the fiestas seemed a pipe dream, but in the end, if the untypical situation allows, they will be celebrated.

The fiesta programme contains a schedule of cultural, fun and religious activities planned so that everyone can enjoy them. New things this year are that, to attend the different events, you will have to put your name down in advance. There will also be control of access to the different events and limited numbers.

Fiestas 2021

The events are designed to take place at their designated moment, but with the possibility to change or cancel them if the circumstances require. Putting together the fiesta programme has been a long and intense job, subject to constant changes, and the Comisión de Fiestas 2020/21 has confronted it and resolved it effectively, working with a lot of eagerness and effort so that the fiestas can be celebrated. Also, the Peña Taurina has added its little grain of sand with its planning of different events with the bulls.

The councillor for Fiestas asks for prudence and responsibility when you take part in the events. You must be very careful with the health and safety measures: keeping the recommended distance, using a facemask, if necessary These are days which all of the people, in general, want to be able to enjoy, as last year the fiestas couldn't take place, so it depends on all of us as to whether this year they can go ahead. Common sense, respect and enjoy the events.

De conformidad con lo dispuesto en el artículo 6.g. del Decreto 52/2021, de 9 de abril, del Consell, de aprobación de los estatutos de la Agència Valenciana de Protecció del Territori y la disposición adicional decimotercera, apartado séptimo de la Ley 5/2014, de 25 de julio, de la Generalitat, de Ordenación del Territorio, Urbanismo y Paisaje, de la Comunitat Valenciana, se hace público el siguiente Acuerdo del Pleno adoptado en sesión celebrada en fecha 15 de junio de 2021:

“1. La adhesión del Ayuntamiento de Beniarbeig a la Agència Valenciana de Protecció del Territori, de conformidad con lo que establecen los Estatutos del mencionado organismo, lo que supone:

a) Delegar la competencia exclusiva en la Agencia en materia de protección de la legalidad urbanística, sanción y restauración de la legalidad urbanística, respecto de infracciones urbanísticas graves o muy graves en suelo no urbanizable, común o protegido, de este municipio, que corresponda a edificaciones que se empiezan a construir a partir de la fecha de publicación de este acuerdo de adhesión.

b) Participar en las decisiones del mencionado organismo, a través de las vocalías de representación municipal del Consejo de Dirección.

c) Respetar este acuerdo de adhesión durante su vigencia.

d) Colaborar con la Agencia en el ejercicio efectivo de sus funciones.

2. Respecto de las infracciones graves o muy graves cometidas en suelo no urbanizable antes de la fecha de publicación de este acuerdo de adhesión, respecto de las cuales no se hubiera iniciado ningún procedimiento municipal, se delega en la Agencia la competencia exclusiva para iniciar, tramitar y resolver el correspondiente procedimiento de restauración de la legalidad urbanística y sancionador.

3. Esta adhesión, una vez confirmada por la Dirección Gerencia, será publicada por la Agencia en el Diari Oficial de la Generalitat Valenciana. La Agencia ejercerá de manera efectiva las competencias que mediante el presente acuerdo se delegan, desde la fecha de publicación del acuerdo de adhesión.

4. Remitir certificado de este acuerdo a la Agència Valenciana de Protecció del Territori.”

Childrens' music and theatre for a cultural June

On Saturday 12th June, the well known 'singer of songs' Dani Miquel visited Beniarbeig with his show «Musiquerías». The event was organised by the Councillor for Culture and funded by the Diputación de Alicante and some 350 people from all over the area attended the event, held in the playground of the old school. People young and old sang and danced to the sound of Dani Miquel who,

accompanied by his full band, presented his full musical repertoire, which makes him a phenomenon in the world of children's music. Two weeks later it was the turn of «CONT@RTE», a show based on the story of 'Alice in Wonderland' (1862) by Lewis Carroll. It was performed by L'Oracle de l'Est and more than 150 people attended.

The Councillor points out that the response of the families has been very positive and that both shows were able to take place in line with all COVID-19 protocols, meaning keeping a safe distance, taking temperatures, wearing masks and sanitising hands. These measures, added to the fact that the events took place outside, maximised safety.



The pool library and the timetable for the summer

After its absence last year, this year the pool library has returned so that bathers can have a selection of books within easy reach. Among the books are children's books, books in English, short novels, classics or regional publications. All of the books can be taken home without the need to ask anyone, you are just asked to return the book to the pool library once you have finished it.

With the arrival of summer, the Reading Club is also taking a break after its 8th July session, when the members of the

reading group shared their impressions of *La bruma verde*, by Gonzalo Giner. The Beniarbeig readers found the book entertaining and easy to read, it mixes the genres of thriller, romance and adventure to highlight important problems such as the deforestation of the Congolese forest, which is not only an environmental drama but also a cultural and human one.

Finally, during the months of July and August, the library will be open in the mornings, more specifically from Monday to Friday, 10am to 2pm.



The pigeon breeders end their season with a local competition

The Concurso de Colombicultura de Beniarbeig took place during the month of June and, with six releases, the local pigeon breeders tested their pigeons. Some twenty members of the Club de Colombicultura «La Estrella» flew a total of 85 pigeons, among which was «Triana» (1), owned by Miguel Sola (2) which, with 1,124 points, took first prize. With only three points less, «Tic rojo» owned by Pedro Gadea (3) finished in second place, while the bronze prize went to Francisco Vicente Gilabert «Peña», whose «Messenger» gave him 1,065 puntos y his colleague Andrés Gil (4). Fourth and fifth places went to «Oscuro deseo» owned by Diego Piera (5) and «Garrapata» owned by Juan Vicente Seguí, for whom Antonio Seguí (6) collected the prize.

Vicent Llorenç (7) as president of the club, explains that «because we couldn't hold the competition last year, this year we really wanted to hold it, and it's all gone fairly well, except for the last day, when a fox got the hen bird and 6 more pigeons», a loss which we regret.

Once the releases were finished, on Saturday 3rd July they held a brotherhood lunch at the Bar Club de Pensionistas, when trophies were handed out to the winners by the mayor Juanjo Mas (8). It was also an occasion to thank José Pedro Moreno (9) for his work over the months, looking after the pigeons, for which he was presented with a plaque of recognition.

With the heat and the plumage change in the pigeons, the local pigeon breeders end a season

marked by the recent regional championship which finished in May.

The Erasmus+ programme collaborates with the preparation of the space for young people

The incorporation of Beniarbeig Town Hall into the Xarxa Jove de la Marina Alta has allowed a group of young people aged between 16 and 18 from various countries, such as France and Italy, to help with tasks to adapt the old school into a space for young people in collaboration with the Councillor for Youth.

The campaign is part of the Agenda Valenciana Antidespoblament (AVANT) and in this case is managed by DeAmicitia, an entity which

works with international volunteer camps and has a house in Sanet i els Negrals, from where the young people are collaborating with the towns and the villages in the Girona valley.

Councillor Sara Gil Peretó has thanked the volunteers for their work, as they have already helped to «take out rubbish, take out nails and put up tape prior to painting, so that the space can be available for young people from the autumn onwards».



Beniarbeig Football Club ends a season cut short by the pandemic

The last match of the season took place on 14th June between C.F Beniarbeig - VillajoyosaCF «B». With a score of 2-4 in favour of the team from the Marina Baixa, the Beniarbeig team settled for third place in the 2ª Regional Plata league, which for the general classification is the equivalent of tenth place. As the president of the club Javier Picornell Carpi explains, «this year, halfway through the season, they had to divide the league into two, because in January and February we couldn't play and in this way they could shorten the season a bit.». This formula didn't prevent the season from finishing a month later than usual.

The team is now resting and recovering their strength to start the pre-season training before the end of the summer. For Picornell the 2021-2022 season can be viewed with optimism

because «we have managed to create a very good atmosphere within the team and most of the players intend to continue». As for the results, ahead of the new season the president hopes to be able to improve its classification, although at the moment, the biggest challenge is to find a replacement for Àlex Pulido, the trainer who has led the Beniarbeig team this season. The trainer said goodbye with a letter to the «CF Beniarbeig family», in which he doesn't skimp on thanks to the players, the committee and the fans and in

which he says how much he enjoyed his stay at the Camp del Girona. The committee confirms that they are now trying to get a replacement for Pulido, a search that is already quite well advanced and they hope soon to be able to announce a name.

During what's left of the summer, while sporting activity is at a standstill, CF Beniarbeig will take advantage of the break to devote itself more to the social side of the club and they hope to celebrate their AGM with members at the end of July.



Formation of a new community association in Beniarbeig

Although the name still has to be decided, more than thirty residents attended the two meetings held in the Centro Cultural in Beniarbeig in June to show their interest in this new association.

After these two meetings it was concluded that the association will be based on volunteering, it will carry out social and environmental activities (from

the temporary care of pets to the collection of rubbish from green spaces) and that the services of the association will be available to all residents whether they are members of the association or not. In the association, for the moment, languages used are Valenciano, Spanish, English, French and German.

The committee, recently elected at the second meeting of the

Pets and the summer

With the heat of the summer months it's important to remember that high temperatures also affect our pets. For example, in the case of dogs, heatstroke can be fatal. So you should avoid long walks during the hottest hours of the day, not only because of the air temperature but also because of the temperature of the pavement, which can be very abrasive for the dogs' footpads. In fact, with an air temperature of 25°C, tarmac can reach temperatures of 52°C, and with an air temperature of 31°C, pavements exposed to the sun can easily reach 62°C.

In addition, you are recommended to take a small amount of water so that the dog can drink and you can cool down your pet. All of these measures are particularly important for older dogs, Nordic breeds and flat nosed breeds.

Another aspect which is

especially relevant during the summer is that of excrement and urine on the public highway, as the heat intensifies the bad smell and the risk of infections.

Although regularly leaving excrement on the street is a clearly reprehensible act, it is even more so in the heat. In the case of urine, you are recommended to rinse with water the area where the dog has done a wee.

After recently seeing some antisocial behaviour of this kind,

the Councillor for the Environment and the local police have intensified their surveillance of this kind of offence, which carries a fine of 40€.



Multisports week: the starting pistol for the sports schools

Over the last days of June, the sports centre hosted the second multisports week organised by the Ayuntamiento de Beniarbeig, in which 39 children aged from 5 to 10 took part. Among the sports practised were court games like basketball, football and padel, but also cycling, making use of the football pitch and adjacent land to design a circuit for the bikes. As planned, the young sports fanatics also made use of the pool, not only to refresh themselves but also to play water games.

Heading the activities were the instructors Betty Llopis, Raxel Lafuente and Anabel Ahuir who say that they were very happy with the number of participants and by their attitude. In fact, Llopis said “the boys and girls have enjoyed themselves, when we asked some of them which had been their favourite activity, they started to name nearly all of them and that means that they enjoyed them”. Llopis also



explained that the facilities available in the village are spacious and are in good condition, which makes it easier to do so many different sports.

From the Town Hall, the mayor Juanjo Mas also agrees that the feedback on participation was positive and he hopes that the good sensation left by the multisports week might lead to

the formation of some groups in the village's sports schools. This is fundamental for Mas «because we all know how beneficial sport is for children of these ages and the town hall has been trying to give new life to the sports schools for some time».

In fact, from now until 15th August, pre-registration is open for the village's sports schools. The aim of pre-registration is to hold a first poll among those boys and girls interested in doing a sport, to find out the viability of forming groups for basketball, five a side football, handball, padel, volleyball or pelota, which are those on offer this year. 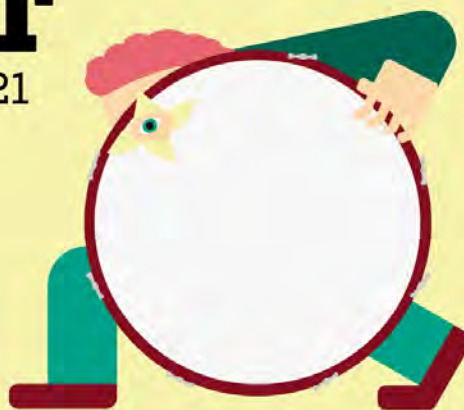
